



SPARE TIRE COVER INSTRUCTIONS



Congratulations, you have purchased what we believe is the finest quality spare tire cover available. With proper care your cover will reward you with years of reliable service.

For your convenience, the following instructions have been organized in two sections:

- 1 - Installation & Removal
- 2 - Care & Maintenance

1 - Installation & Removal

Disconnect the two (2) shock cord hooks. Position the cover so that the hooks are located at the bottom or 6 o'clock position. Slip the cover over the top of the tire, then stretch the elastic band and pull the cover onto the tire, covering the tire's tread. Make adjustments to the cover placement and then connect the shock cord hooks.

To remove the cover, disconnect the shock cord hooks and peel the cover off.

OR: If your model of spare tire cover **does not have shock cord hooks**, slip the cover over the top of the tire. Next, stretch the elastic band and pull the cover onto the tire, covering the treads. To remove, just reverse the installation process.

2 - Care & Maintenance

Use cool/warm soapy water and a soft nylon brush or cloth, when necessary, to clean your tire cover. Rinse off any residual soap with clean water. For vinyl covers, any major brand vinyl protectant may be used on your tire cover, if desired.

DO NOT put the cover in a washing machine or dryer!
